He achieved 2 Gold Medals at the 2006 Common Wealth Games Melbourne, 2006 Asian games Bronze Medal (Doha), 2007 Asian championship silver medal (Kuwait city), 2009 Silver medal at ISSF (Beijing), 2010 Common Wealth Games 3 gold and 1 silver (Delhi), 2012 London Olympics Silver medal. He was honored with Arjun Award (2007), Rajev Gandhi Khel Ratan (2010), Padam Shree (2013).

- 5. Even though there was no other member of his family who was a sports person yet his parents provided him required moral assistance mainly because he showed lots of promises as a shooter.
- 6. Mr. Vijay Kumar has participated in shooting competitions at the age of 17 years and his performance in these competitions served as a great source of motivation which compelled him to continue systematic training initially under the supervision of his Army training stage and thereafter under the care of reputed Russian coach Mr. Pavel Smirnov.
- 7. Even though Mr. Vijay Kumar did not have any outstanding person as ideal / model yet he trained systematically to bring himself to level of an International sportsperson.
- 8. Mr. Vijay Kumar did not get sports science support and whatever level of performance he achieved was all due to his hard work and the guidance of this coach.
- Mr. Vijay Kumar attended training camps organized by Sports Authority of India and also attended systematic training in the following academies.
