(STAT@MDR-2016)

## Duties of Authors

**Reporting Standards:** Authors should present an accurate account of their original research as well as an objective discussion of its significance. Manuscripts will follow the submission guidelines of this book.

**Originality:** Authors must ensure that they have written entirely original work.

**Multiple, Redundant, or Concurrent Publications:** Authors should not submit the same manuscript to other journal or book. It is also expected that the author will not publish redundant manuscripts or manuscripts describing the same research in more than one journal / book.

**Acknowledgement of Sources:** Authors should acknowledge all sources of data used in the research and cite publications that have been influential in the research work.

**Authorship of the Paper:** Authorship should be limited to those who have made a significant contribution to conception, design, execution or interpretation of the reported study. Others who have made significant contribution must be listed as co-authors. The corresponding author also ensure that all the authors have agreed to the submitted version of the manuscript and their inclusion of names as co-authors.

**Data Access and Retention:** Authors should provide raw data related to their manuscript for editorial review and must retain such data.

**Fundamental Errors in Published Works:** If at any point of time, the author(s) discovers a significant error or inaccuracy in submitted manuscript, then the error or inaccuracy must be reported to the editor.

## Ethics

All the authors should be followed standard guidelines and they should indicate whether the procedures followed as the guidelines and ethical standards. If needed, the study should be obtained the ethical clearances from the ethical committee and author should indicate the ethical clearance number or project /proposal approval number in the method section.

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Plagiarism is the copying of ideas, text, data and other creative work (e.g. tables, figures and graphs) and presenting it as original research without proper citation. Plagiarism is a serious violation. We define plagiarism as a case in which a paper reproduces another work with at least 20% similarity and without citation. If evidence of plagiarism is found before or after acceptance or after publication of the paper, the author will be offered a chance to defence his\her paper.

47 This section should deal with the materials used and the methodology - how the work  
48 was carried out. The procedure adopted should be described in sufficient detail to  
49 allow the study to be interpreted and repeated by the readers, if necessary. The details  
50 of statistical tests used and the level of significance should be stated.

53 You should provide your original data set / contribution

54 You can explain your results with separate sub headings

56 **Discussion**

57 You should discuss your results with previous reports

58 You may use separate sub headings

60 **Conclusions**

61 Authors should state the main conclusions clearly and not in vague statements.

64 Acknowledge only persons who have contributed to the scientific content or provided  
65 technical support. Sources of financial support (institute or other source) may also
